

Lighting your Ethos Woodfire

The secret to getting the best heat and efficiency out of your Ethos Woodfire is to get the firebox up to operating temperature as quickly as possible. Follow these steps to ensure quick and hassle free lighting.

You will need:

1 firelighter

About twelve to fifteen sticks of small dry kindling

Four or more pieces of medium sized dry firewood approx 65 to 70mm diameter ↓

- 1 Ensure the air control on the right hand side is in its fully open position
- 2 Position the firelighter in the center front of the firebox just behind the door
- 3 Place two pieces of kindling from front to back alongside the firebricks
- 4 Build the kindling pile alternating crosswise and lengthwise as shown
- 5 Place four or more pieces of medium sized (approx 65 to 70mm dia) dry wood across kindling to a height about level with the top of the firebricks.
- 6 Light the firelighter and close the door **immediately**

DO NOT OPEN THE DOOR FOR APPROXIMATELY 20 – 30 MINUTES.

By this time the first load should have burned down to a bed of glowing embers and more dry wood can then be loaded.
